

1. Availability of the grant (Section 5 of the original Memorandum and Attachment B of the original Memorandum and the subsequent Amendment no. 1)


The estimated time for completion of the Research Work is now 24 months from the Commencement date of 1 May 2005.





- ① The technical progress reports must contain sufficient information for Centre staff to determine the progress of the Project as well as its technical success. Guidelines for report preparation are available on the Centre's Web Site (http://network.idrc.ca/ev.php?URL_ID=26079&URL_DO=DO_TOPIC&URL_SECTION=201) or from the Centre's contact (see Section 4.1 of the Memorandum).
- ② All technical reports are to be prepared jointly by the Recipient and all Collaborating Institutions or as deemed acceptable by the Centre's contact (see Section 4.1 of the Memorandum).

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- ③ The amount of these payments will be based upon an analysis by the Centre of the accounted expenditures as well as of the forecast submitted by the Administering Institution as identified in Section 2 of the Memorandum. Refer to Section A10.2 for the reporting requirements and to A10.3 for the frequency of payments. Grant advances typically cover half a year's cash requirements.
- ④ The final technical report must contain sufficient information detailing the work accomplished – embodying research findings, project results and outcomes, any policy recommendations and an acceptable dissemination plan where dissemination did not take place within the scope of the project – in order to allow Centre staff to determine its technical success. Guidelines for report preparation are available at the Centre's web site (http://web.idrc.ca/ev_en.php?ID=26080_201&ID2=DO_TOPIC) or from the Centre's contact (see Section 4.1 of the Memorandum).
- ⑤ The amount of the final payment indicated here is based upon either the forecast of the initial grant budget *or a revised budget if applicable*. The actual amount will be such that the net grant amount administered by the Recipient will not be exceeded – this is determined on the basis of the total amount awarded to the Recipient on page one of the Memorandum *or in any subsequent amendment of the Memorandum*, less the amount administered by the Centre as per Attachment C of this Memorandum.

If the Recipient fails to submit any one of the above-mentioned final reports by the Completion Date, the Centre may close the Project. In such an instance, the Centre shall withhold all final payments and may request the Recipient to return any unspent and unaccounted funds.
